- 2.3 In the event of entries exceeding 60 the latest player at the time of application will be kept on a reserve list.
- 2.4 The competition draw will be made after 29<sup>th</sup> August 2018.
- 2.5 Competitors **MUST** register at the Registration Desk **no later than 30 minutes before their first tee time.**
- 2.6 A current Competition CONGU Handicap Certificate or CDH number must be produced at registration. Failure to do so will mean disqualification.
- 2.7 Any competitor who is aged under 14 must be accompanied by a responsible adult. Players aged under 18 years must produce a copy of their current Parental Consent Form.
- 2.8 The organiser has the authority to arrange / alter tee times.

- 3.3 The competition shall consist of **36 Holes Stroke Play**
- 3.3 In the event of a tie the winners will be decided on a count back basis over the last 18, 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole(s) on the card of the final round. **Players may only win one prize.**
- 3.5 If a player arrives at their starting point ready to play within five minutes after their starting time, in the absence of circumstances that warrant the waiving of the penalty of disqualification under Rule 33.7, the penalty for failure to start on time is **TWO STROKES** on stroke play. **Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is DISQUALIFICATION.**
- 3.6 The ball used must be on the R&A Conforming Ball List. The penalty is disqualification.
- 3.7 Distance Measuring Devices may be used.
- 3.8 Players should walk at all times unless permitted to ride by the organising committee on production of a current medical certificate (refer to England Golf Transportation Policy).
- 3.9 Competitors may not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddy. The penalty is disqualification.
- 4 The organiser and referees will monitor the pace of play and will take action under the Rules of Golf if players are considered to be delaying play.
